Tips to remember:

- NEVER share personal or financial information and details over the phone to someone unknown - especially if they are calling YOU - or on social media.
- Think with your head instead of your heart if you get a call from your 'grandson' or favorite 'niece' asking for bail money or to pay a hospital bill
- Educate yourself on scam tactics like love bombing and urgency creation (remember think with your head!)

The Jacob Henry Estate Mansion will be hosting a Tribute to Elvis with highly respected tribute artist, Logan Ramey. Backed by The Memphis Flash Band, expect a musical experience!

Upon arrival to the estate, guests will have time to take a self-guided tour of the beautifully kept mansion. Jacob Henry was a wealthy railroad magnate who built his home among the other stately merchant-owned homes along what was known as "Silk Stocking Row". Built over a three year period, the mansion features elaborate, hand-carved wood throughout including ornately

carved fireplaces in every room and beautiful Victorian furniture. Named a National Historic Landmark, it is one of the largest and best examples of Renaissance Revival architecture still standing in the state of Illinois.
